#### **Archery:**

Come and try your archery skills. Instructors will work with participants if you have never shot a bow and arrow or if you have your own equipment, targets will be set up for you to try. **Cost - Free**

#### **22 Rimfire:**

We will have .22 caliber rifles for you to shoot at knock down metal plate targets Kids are always welcome to sharpen their shooting skills at this station. Instructors will also be on the range to assist. **Cost - Free**

#### **Tomahawk Throwing:**

Outdoorsmen of all ages can try their skill at sticking a tomahawk in a wooden target. **Cost - Free**

#### **Five-Stand Sporting Clays:**

This is a 25 round shotgun course that anyone can try. Participants shoot in turn at each of the five stands. There is a menu card that will advise the shooter of the sequence of targets. 5-Stand is a great way to get a Sporting Clays like experience with very little walking. **Cost - \$7.00 plus your shells and a tip for your trapper**

#### **Youth / Ladies Wing Shooting Clinic:**

This is a chance to introduce a new shooter to the clay shooting sports. We will have instructors available to show you the basics of gun safety and handling, then we will break some targets! Youth shotguns will be available to use. Kids must be over the age of 10 years. **Cost - You will need to purchase shells, available at the club.**

#### **Bring Your Own - Picnic Lunch**

Pack a picnic lunch for you and your family to enjoy. Lawn chairs, blanket, cooler, whatever you want to bring, God will provide the shade tree. It's an all you can eat event, because it's up to you to bring as much as you want to eat!!!

#### **Sporting Clays:**

Have a blast shotgun shooting at clay targets thrown to simulate actual game hunting scenarios. Challenge the 100 round course shot at ten different stations, usually thrown in pairs. **Cost - \$30.00 plus your shells and a tip for your trapper.**
